'On yer Bike!'

Bikeability began this week for children in Years 3 & 4.

We had twenty-one children take the Level One training course which lasted for two days, on Tuesday and Wednesday.

This was a great uptake and success rate too. With the aid of our instructors we were able to 'hire' bicycles for those children who could ride, but didn't own their own bike (or they were simply too big for their old bike).

The children practised the skills of riding and being able to look around behind; ride with one hand; and how to give clear hand signals.

If they could do these skills, plus a few others they passed their 'Test'!

Cycling is a great thing to do, when done safely.

That's what 'Bikeability' encourages.
