

## PUPIL PREMIUM OUTCOME FOR SUMMER 2015

In the key areas of Reading , Writing and Maths at Key Stage 2, the percentage difference for Disadvantaged Pupils at the school is less in each area than those nationally. In terms of Average Point Score, again, the difference between Disadvantaged Pupils and others is less in Reading, Writing and Grammar ,Punctuation & Spelling, than found nationally. In Maths, Writing and Grammar Punctuation & Spelling, Disadvantaged Pupils at St James out performed similar groups nationally. However the school is looking to close this gap further.
