Beautiful Brass

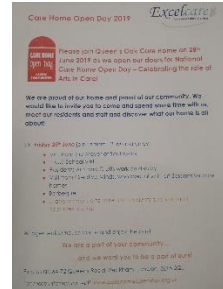
Last Sunday nineteen children performed at the prestigious TowerWater Music Festival at the Tower of London. This is
