


Year 6 Celebration Page

Onyeka has written a great advertisement for a joyous journey (rather than the hazardous one Shackleton was advertising).




He has thought carefully about his vocabulary choices (including some of the other *-ous* adjectives that he thought of on Monday) and written a very persuasive advertisement. Well done!

It's also very good to see that he is maintaining the same standards of presentation at home that he knows I would expect from him at school.


I can see from **Daniela's** Maths that she understands how to order negative numbers on a number line with and without marked intervals.

2: Here is a number line without intervals.


a) Estimate where on the number line each number should go then write it in the correct position



Don't forget that, just as in school, if you find you are getting the hang of the Maths activity that you are doing, and beginning to find it easy, you should move on to the more challenging option.


It's great to see that you are keeping up with your Maths and English but make sure that, like these children, you are trying your best across the whole curriculum.

Princess has done well with the line patterns that I asked you all to try.




You can all do this activity more than once – keep practising until you develop really good control over the lines. The more confident you can become with this now, the better your final piece of artwork will be.




Yohannes has included in his computing some good advice about what to do if you receive a spam email and why they are dangerous.




If there are Spams being sent for you, do not trust them! And do not pass onto them any information because ~~the~~ if you sign up for them they will enter your account and hack some of your money.

The children who are in school have been working hard too. Have a look at some of the work they have done this week.




Jeremiah's advertisement is very persuasive. It sounds like a lot of fun!

Viola's Maths is very clear and she has used number lines to make sure that she really understands the concept of calculating across 0. Soon she will be ready to move on to an abstract method!


Lilo identify the qualities needed to undertake a mission to Antarctica.
