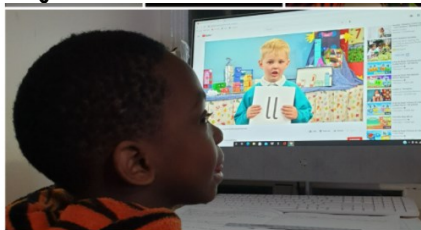

(If you are working at home)

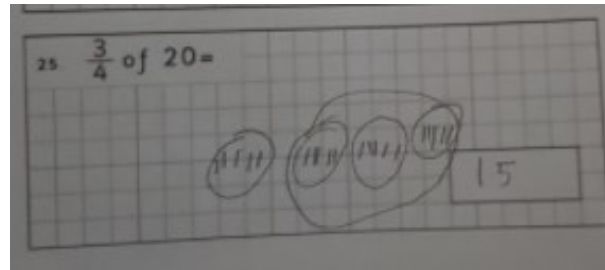

Remote learning: Yoel working on his phonics at home this week

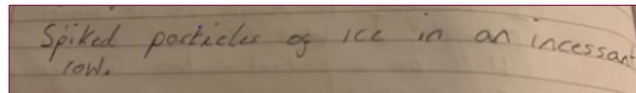

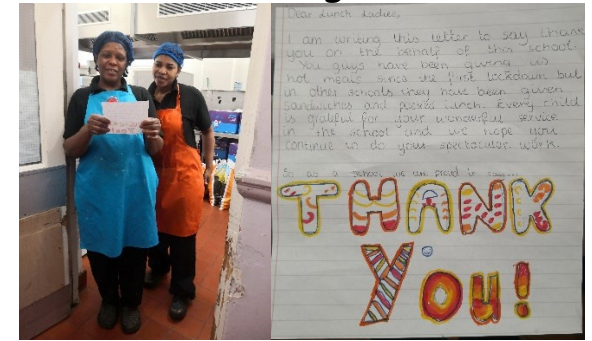
