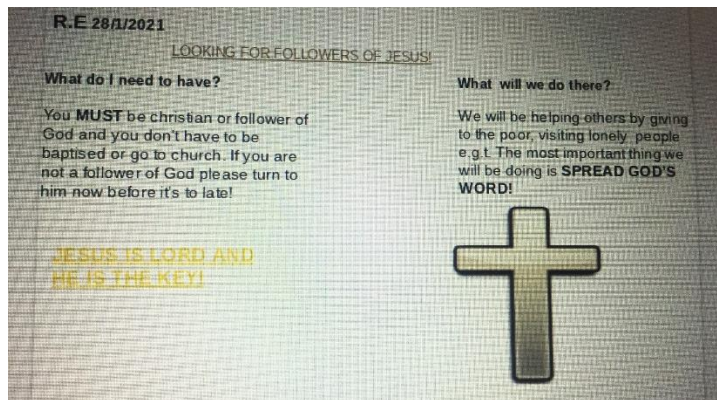

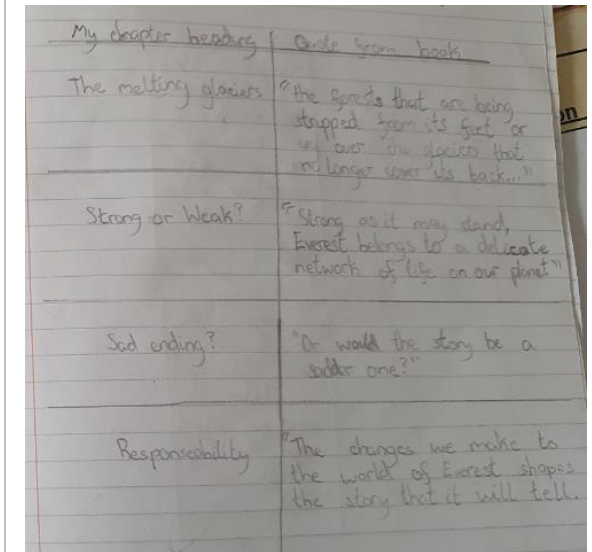
### Celebration of work page

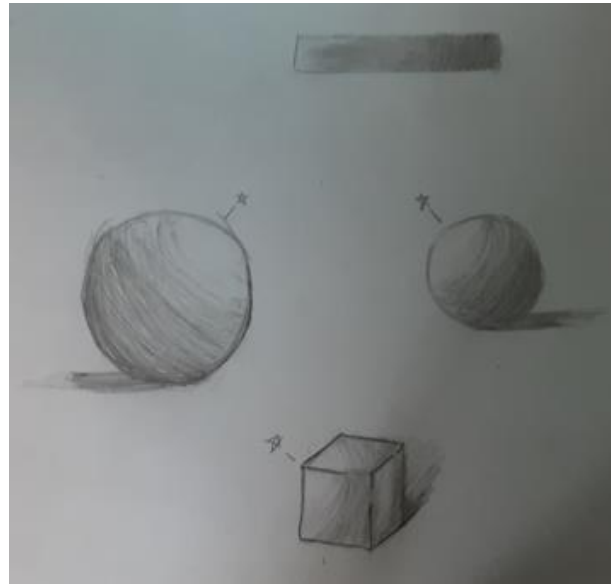
