Direct speech are the actual words a speaker uses.

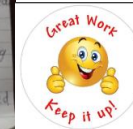
Rules:

- The words spoken are enclosed in single or double quotation marks.
- The comma comes inside a quotation mark if it's finished sentence.
- The comma comes outside the quotation mark if a sentence is split into parts.

Indirect speech means something that has spoken, does not use the actual words that the speaker uttered.

Rules:

- No any quotation marks are used.
- It includes always 2 clauses.
- The main clause with the reporting verb usually comes before the reported clause.
- The actual words are represented in the reported clause.




