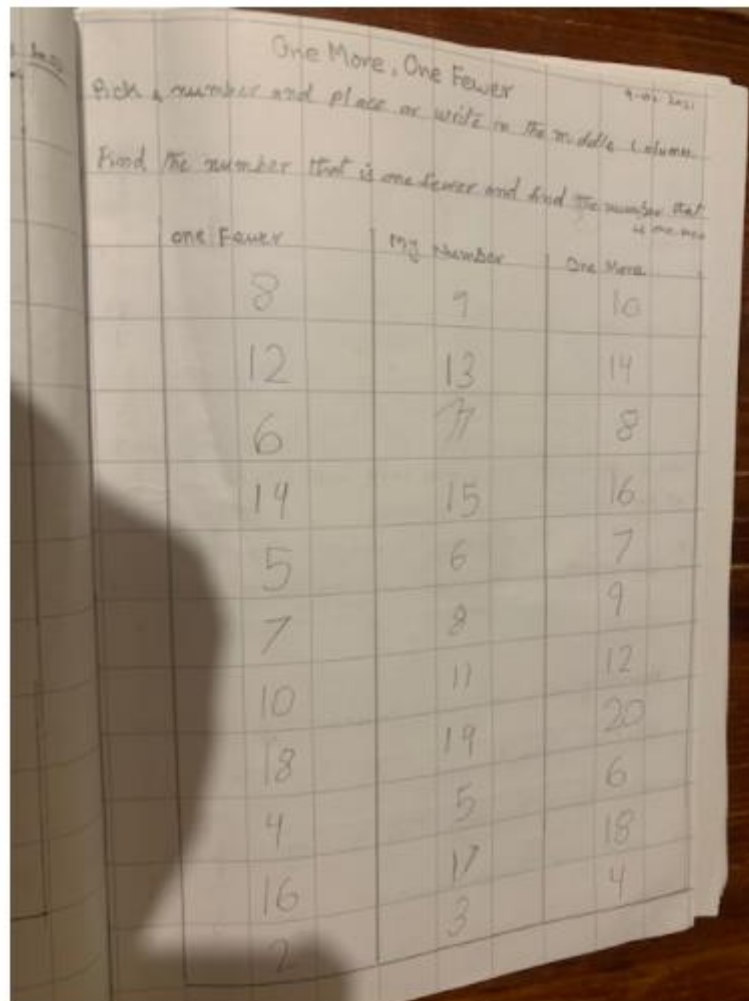

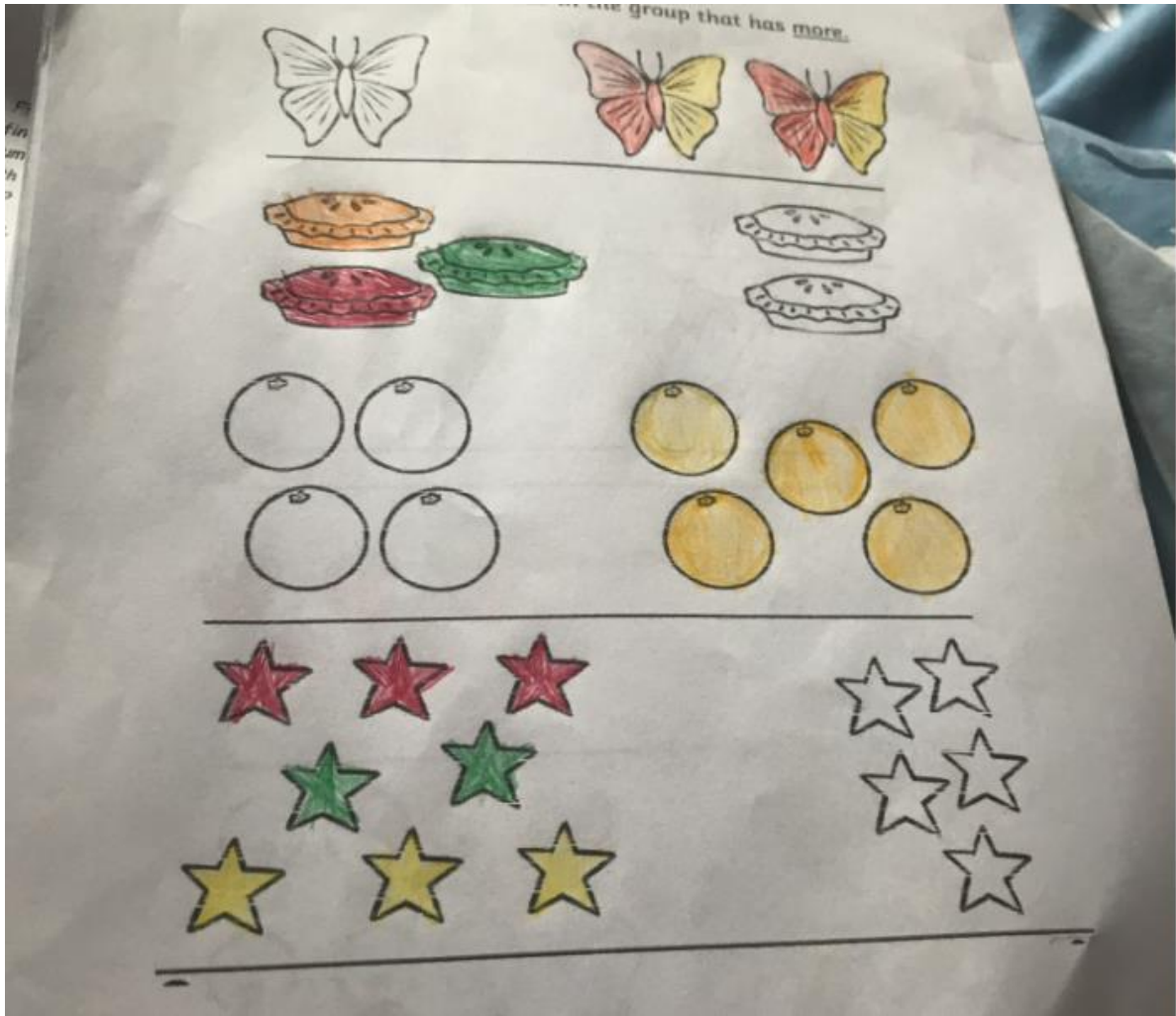
Year One Celebration Page

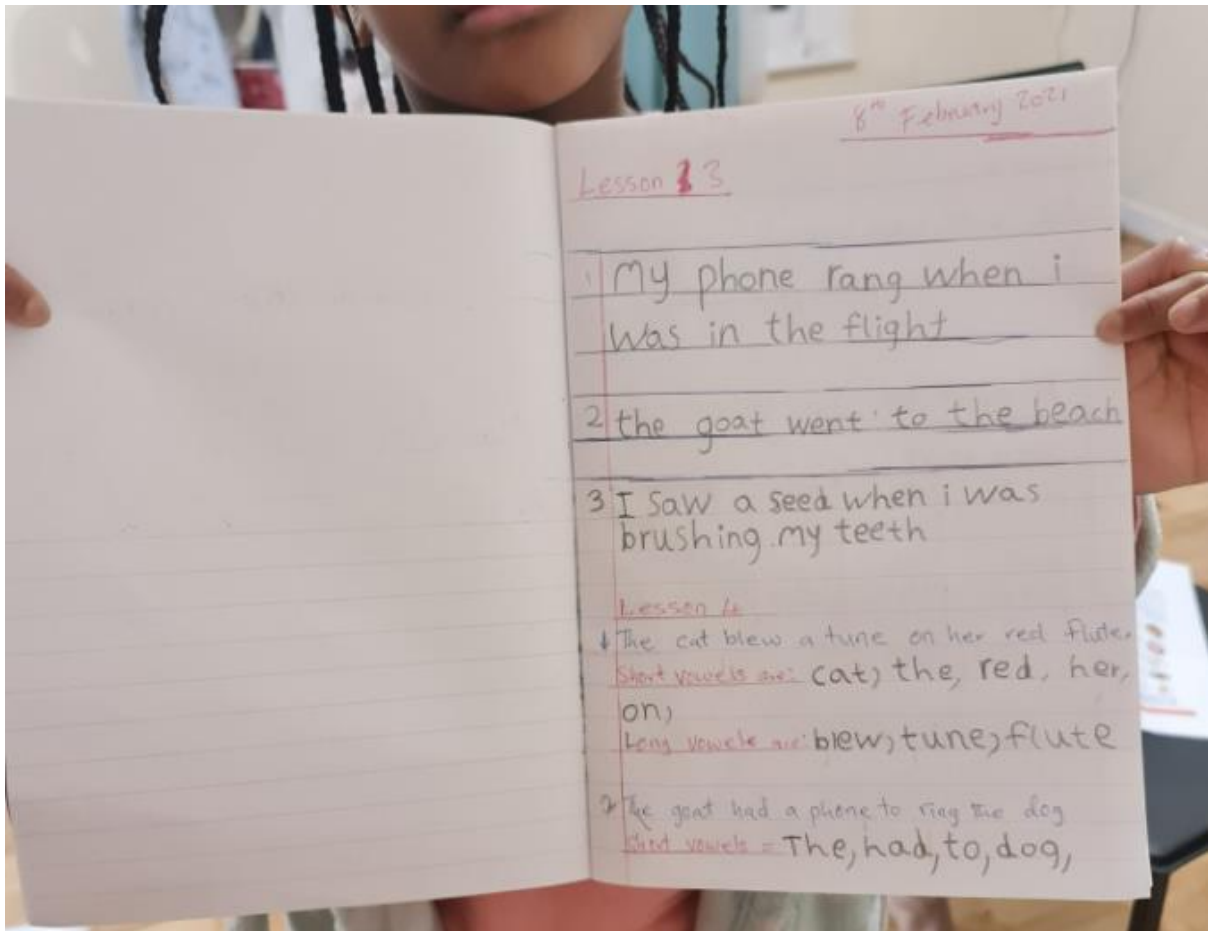

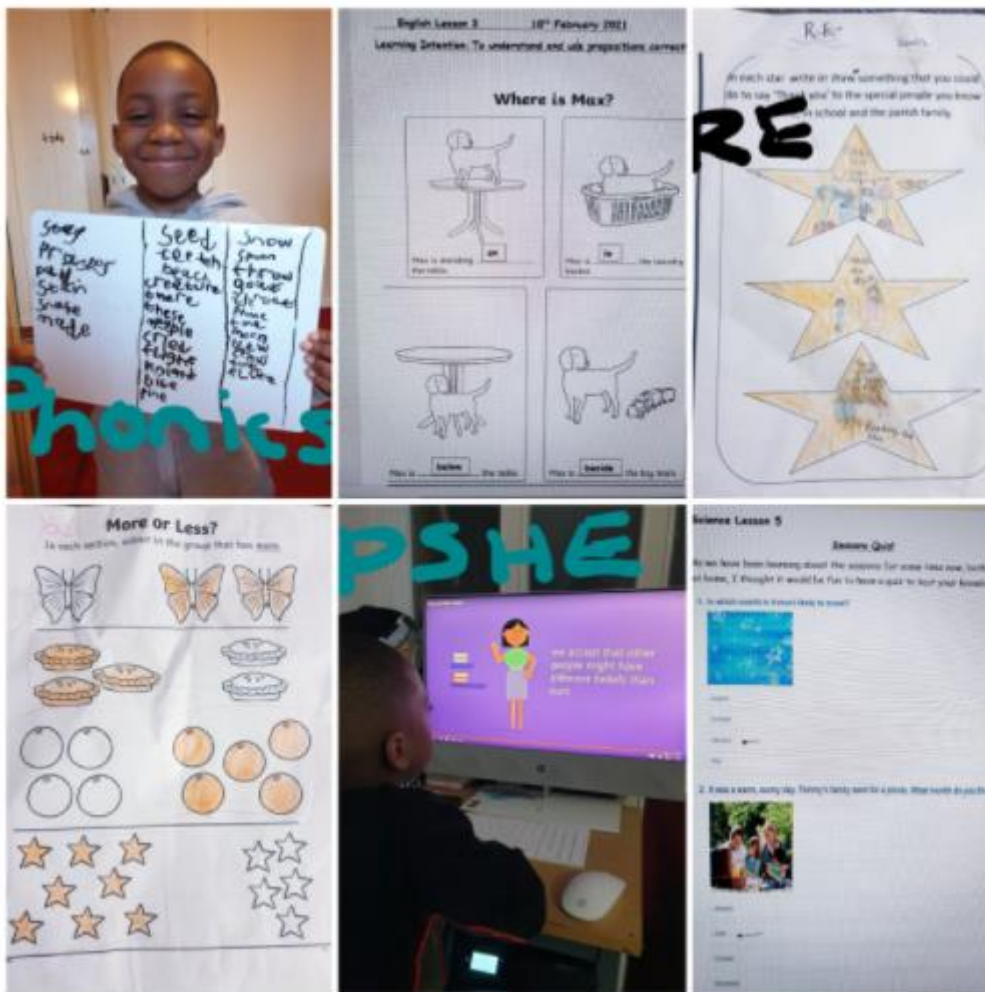
