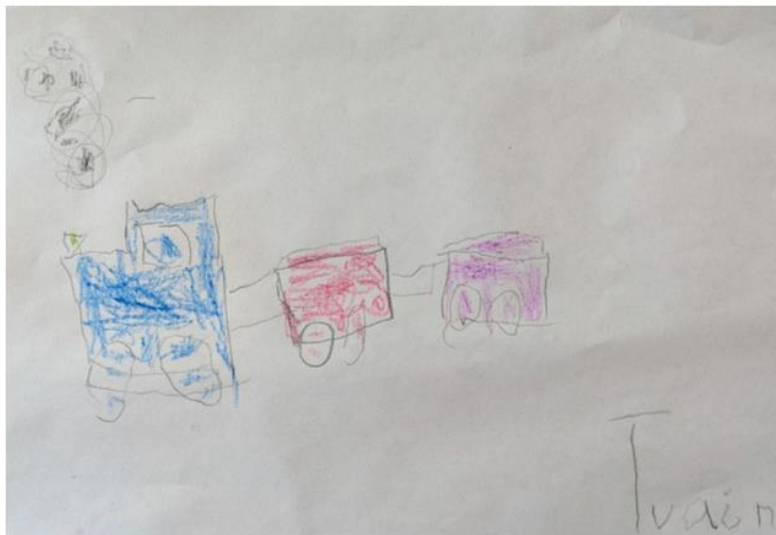
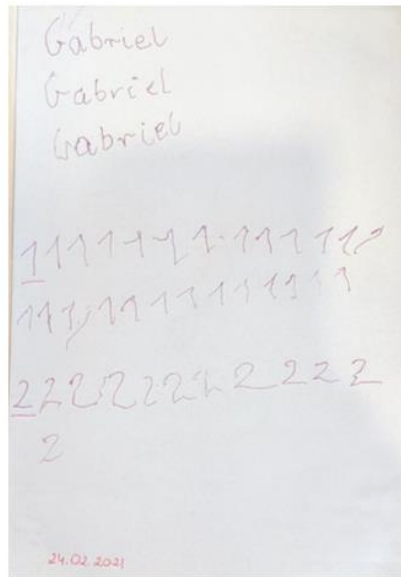
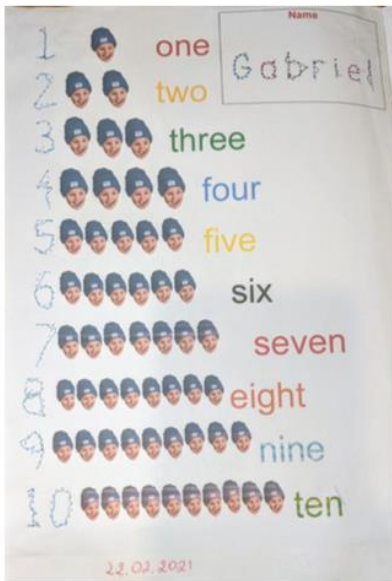
Sponge pieces
