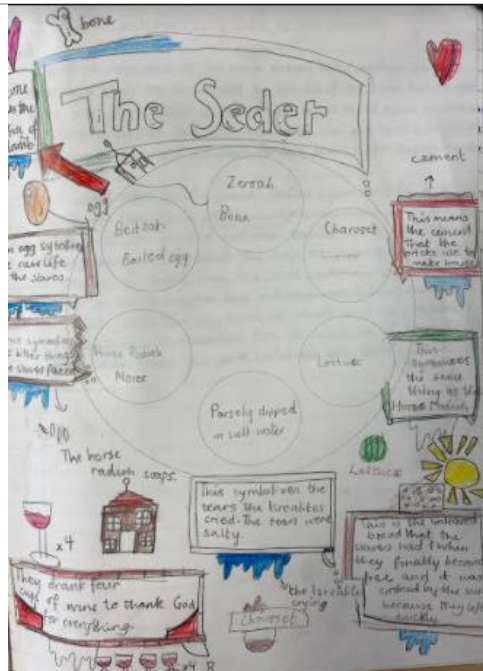

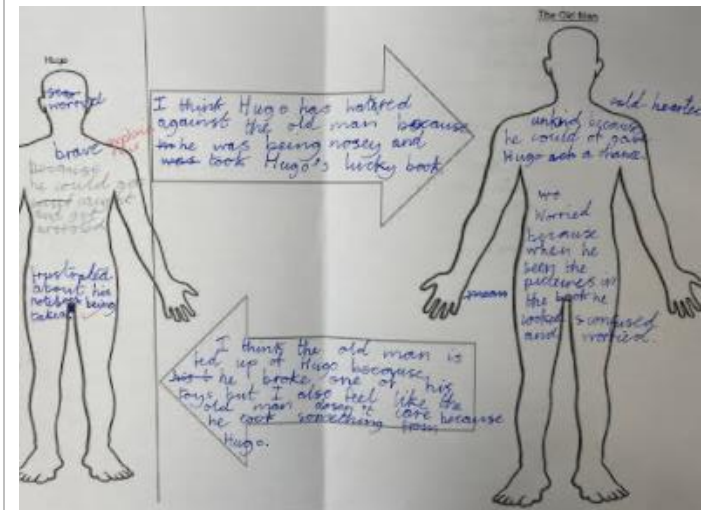

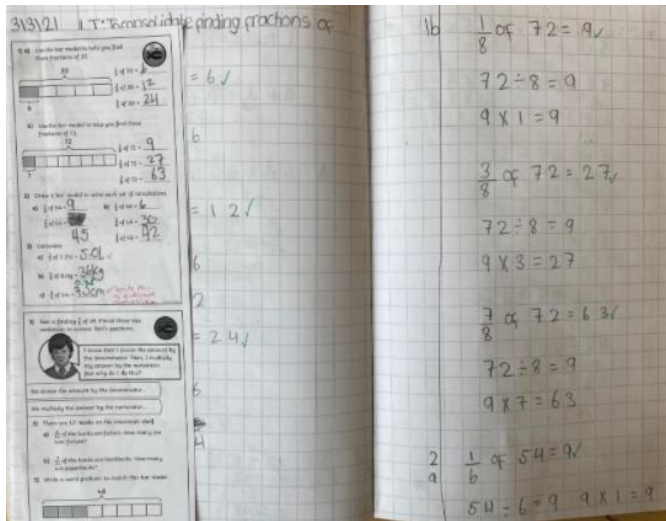
English

Gift used interesting adverbial phrases in her English work on The Invention of Hugo Cabret, to describe how she



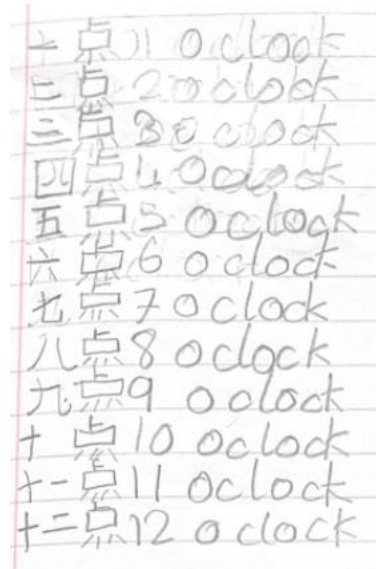
Reading

Tommy contrasted how characters might feel on the inside with how they would appear from the outside and then wrote about the different feelings the characters might have towards each other.



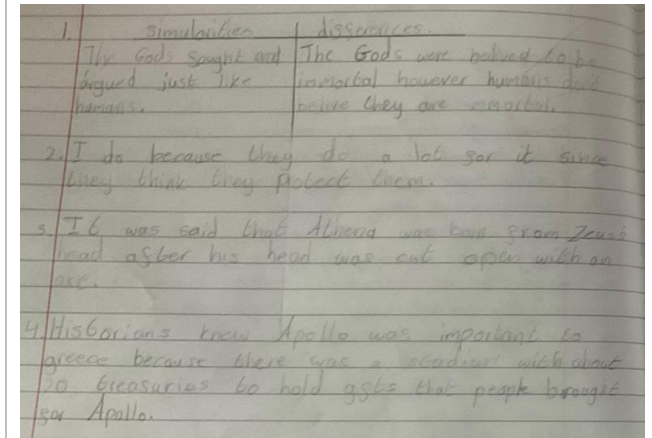
Maths
