BODY of CHRIST**

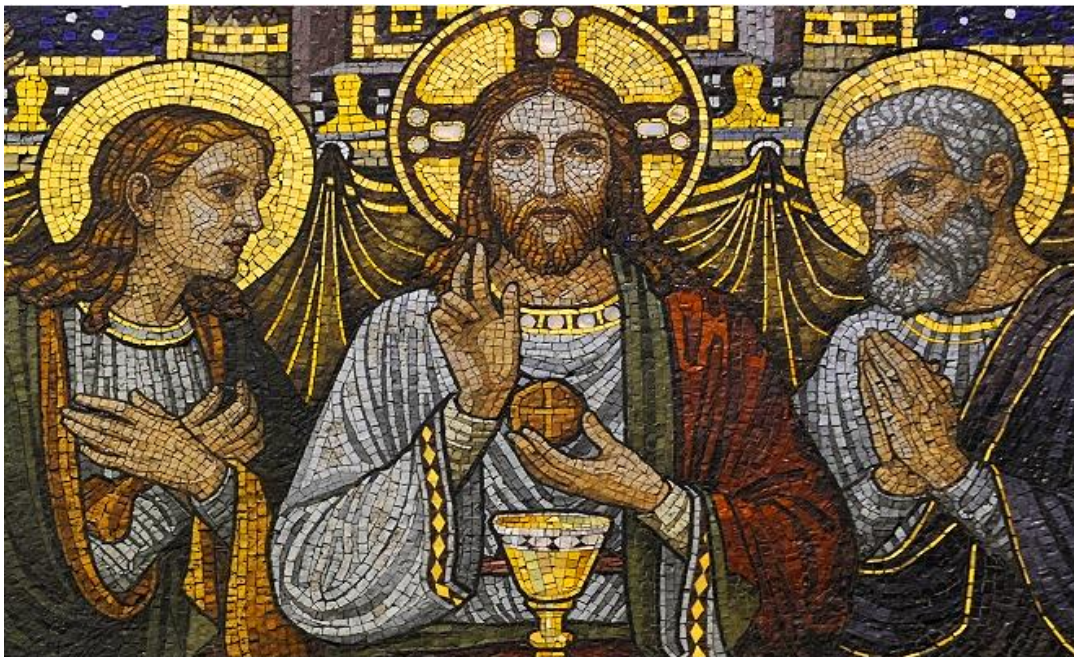
There are many images that come to mind of the Body of Christ.
