The image of the Sacred Heart reminds us of the unconditional love of God.

But look at the other symbols in the picture. They're painful ones that remind us of the 'Crown of thorns' and the spear that pierced Jesus' side on the Cross. In other words, those things show us how far God went to let us know he loves us.
