Paul was originally an enemy of Christians, although he lived at the same time, he didn't even meet Jesus but he had such a change of heart when he found out about him that he went on to spread the Gospel in many different places, he then wrote letters to the people in the places he had been to, to help them to 'Keep the Faith'!
