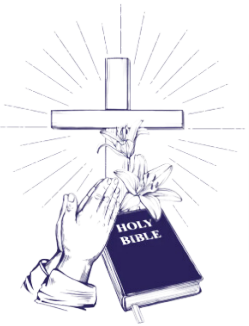
"Doing our best for God, for others and for ourselves"
