<p><b>What we will learn</b></p>	<p>As we are settling in, we can build on our previous knowledge using simple vocabulary to describe the seasons and weather. Name some parts of the body and 5 senses and where located on body by asking/ answering questions. We can identify and discuss feelings and emotions.</p>	<p>We will use simple vocabulary to describe different festivals especially favourite ones and retell the Christmas Story. We will talk about hibernation and at least 2 nocturnal animals. We will know that it is light in daytime/dark at night time and motivated to ask questions about Light/Dark.</p>	<p>We can retell the story of at least 3 favourite Fairy Tales and recite some Nursery Rhymes. We can name, explore and sort different materials using basic classification and ask questions like 'What are houses, bridges, clothes made of?'</p>	<p>We will be able to ask questions about different transport modes such as - How they move? What mode we might use to get to different places? How and why we travel? We will continue to classify objects according to an attribute and identify push and pull forces and experiment with how objects move.</p>	<p>We will sequence the life cycles of plants/animals using simple vocabulary; name farm animals/babies and categorise and describe minibeasts and insects. We will talk about what living things need to live; how to look after our environment and learn about the importance of recycling.</p>	<p>We will be Treasure Island pirates! We will look at similarities and differences when discussing features in our local environment and other habitats developing key vocabulary, questioning, observation and basic prediction skills - floating and sinking.</p>
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
